



Lovis Corinth: Picture "Vase of Flowers on a Table" (1922), framed

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Corinth's late work is of particular importance. First of all, there are the Walchensee pictures, which were painted near Urfeld in the south of Munich from 1919 onwards and in which the painter rediscovered landscape painting for himself. But he also sought and found new approaches in other subjects, such as portraits.

The picture "Flower Vase on a Table" from 1922, shows how another classical subject continued to develop in his work as he grew older. A little over a decade earlier, he had painted still lifes on canvas that still clearly emphasised their reference to the Old Masters and came across in deep, Rembrandtian brown tones. However, this is a watercolour which shows an armchair to the right and a dog nestled in its basket to the left. We see, in a nutshell, a retreat that promised the painter peace and relaxation.
