Andy Warhol was America's most famous artist. He was considered a revolutionary, an eccentric and the inventor of pop art, all at once. He primarily sought his subjects in the world of advertising, comics and Hollywood superstars. Princess Diana, alongside contemporary icons like Elvis Presley, Jackie Kennedy, and Marilyn Monroe, was part of Warhol's repertoire of images.

The engagement photo of Diana Spencer was taken by Lord Snowdon and served Warhol as a model for his work. Warhol removed Prince Charles from it and placed Princess Diana in the foreground. 26 years after her death, it is now being auctioned by the London auction house Philipps. The estimated price ranges from 1.4 to 2.1 million euros.
