The aesthetics of everyday culture and the standardisation and norming of objects of daily use - these are Ottmar Hörl's major themes. Hörl became known for setting up entire armies of sculptures of, for example, rabbits, Martin Luther or Karl Marx. For the 100th anniversary of the artist colony, Mathildenhöhe in Darmstadt, Germany, Ottmar Hörl transformed the Grimm's fairy tale of the Frog Prince into an art project and installed 800 frogs and 5 steel balls in the Art Nouveau fountain for 100 days.

Following his art projects, Hörl's plastic multiples are already sought-after collector's items. As an ars mundi Exclusive Edition, we have now produced a signed special edition of 980 copies each, made of either gold-plated (24-carat) or fine silver-plated cast metal.
