This boy with a flat hat and knee-length cloak, devotedly and totally absorbed in his playing, blowing the flute, eyes closed, completely at one with his instrument, is seated by Barlach on a round stone. The spirituality, musically and earthiness of the stone merge together into this work of art. With the flowing of lines and gliding surfaces, this work realised a flute melody in a sculptural way.

Sculpture in fine bronze, cast by hand using the Lost-Wax-Process and patinated. Directly moulded from the original and reduced in size (reduction). Limited edition of 980 copies, individually numbered and with the signature "E.
