The Attic sculptor Leochares (375-310 BC), who helped complete one of the ancient Seven Wonders of the World at the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus, realised the ideal of the god-like heroic Olympian with the "Praying Ephebe". In the consecrated district of Diadumenos near Olympia, the radiance of the eternal fire shone on the youth, crowning himself with the fillet of victory. Raising his arms far above his head, he invokes the blessing of the immortals.
