The entire world was on the edge of its seat when Howard Carter finally announced the discovery of Tutankhamun's intact tomb on 4 November 1922. And the result was overwhelming: over 5,000 individual finds, magnificent burial objects made of pure gold, but above all the legendary death mask of the young pharaoh were the reward of the greatest exertions. The mask, which is made of pure gold, was worn over the head and shoulders of Tutankhamun's mummy, who was completely bandaged with linen bandages.
