Bartolomé Murillo was a Spanish painter and the most important representative of the School of Seville, where he worked all his life. He is best known for his depictions of poor, ragged but graceful alley children.

The surface of the motif with tactile and visible canvas structure is sealed with an artist's varnish. A handmade real wood gallery frame with gold leaf gilding completes the perfect appearance.
