The artist Ernst Ludwig Kirchner had lived in Berlin since 1915, and one of his themes was the chic big-city life, which he was able to depict with sharp contours and a sure sense of colour in all its grotesqueness. The First World War soon put an end to all this. Kirchner, who had been conscripted to military service, experienced a mental breakdown. He was then discharged from the army due to illness and moved to Switzerland in 1917 to seek recuperation and to paint again. The second major creative phase turned Kirchner into a nature painter who celebrated the Swiss mountains in bright colours and flowing forms.
