In 1915, Ernst Ludwig Kirchner moved to Berlin, and one of his themes was sophisticated city life, which he depicted with sharp contours and a sure sense of colour in all its grotesqueness. The First World War put an end to all this. Kirchner was drafted for military service but experienced a mental breakdown. He was discharged from the army due to his illness. In 1917, he moved to Switzerland to recuperate and paint again. The second major creative phase turned Kirchner into a nature painter who celebrated the Swiss mountains in bright colours and flowing forms.
