Cherub With Trombone: The festive sound of brass instruments like the trombone is an integral part of Christmas music. Played by a detailed cherub, the trombone creates a festive mood even without notes. Size $18,5 \times 10 \times 9$ cm (h/w/d).

Cherub With Flute: When looking at the impressively natural figure, it seems as if we can hear the typical soft round sound of the transverse flute, which enjoyed great popularity, especially in Baroque music. The cherub, made in traditional craftsmanship, also bears baroque features. Size 19 x 10 x 9 cm (h/w/d).

Cherub With Lute: Angels playing the lute can often be found in Renaissance works of art, as the lute, which is native to various cultures, was considered the queen of instruments in this epoch. Size 19 x 10 x 9 cm (h/w/d).
