The painting "Moonrise at the Sea" from 1821 is a tender allegory of friendship and love: the young women sit in the foreground and look at their two men standing further on the horizon. The two ships on the moonlit sea symbolise the couples' common path of life and love, while the demure separation of the sexes leaves room for friendship.
