Monet loved gardens and always found artistic inspiration here. Even in Paris, his path led him to urban parks and green spaces, such as the Parc Monceau in the 8th and 17th arrondissements, which provided him with many motifs. In June 2009, this picture was sold at Christie's in London for 5.6 million pounds (7.4 million euros) to a collector, making it the most expensive picture at that auction. Original oil on canvas, privately owned.

Brilliantly coloured Fine Art Giclée print on artist's canvas in stretcher frame; the wooden canvas wedges allow the canvas to be restretched with fluctuations in temperature and humidity. Real wood gallery frame. Limited to 499 copies, with certificate. Size 73 x 62 cm (h/w).
