Max Pechstein spent several summers on the Curonian Spit for over 30 years. As a member of the artists' colony Nidden, Pechstein portrayed the Curonian landscape and the people living there - admiring both equally. His work "Keitelkähne Under Sail" was painted during his last stay in Nidden in 1939. Two years earlier, he had been expelled from the Prussian Academy of Arts; his works were now considered "degenerate art". But none of this could take away his love for the Curonian Spit.
