Throughout his life, Marc Chagall considered the choice of colours as a form of expression. "Painting is more necessary for me than food. It seems like a window through which I could have taken flight toward another world," Marc Chagall explained. And this is evident in a large number of pictures and drawings with watercolours, pastels, which may not be so well known. The selection for this collection - a bouquet, dancers and acrobats, and painters with their colour palettes - not only addresses a dream world but also the brave witness to the unexpected. "It is the life that creates the contrast between the unimaginable and the imperfect," Chagall said.

To renew these "messages" and share them with the world, highlighted by a contemporary view, the Chagall Committee has commissioned a reproduction on porcelain from Bernardaud.

The inspiration for this large underplate (which can also be used as a bowl) is the circular ceiling painting Chagall created in 1963 for the Opéra Garnier in Paris. The opera house itself and a ballet group are depicted amidst Chagall-typical motifs. Further references to the home of the "Phantom of the Opera" are l'Arc de Triomphe and - unmistakably - the Eiffel Tower. Diameter 36 cm. Dishwasher safe. © ADAGP, Paris, 2015 - Chagall ®
