Ernst Ludwig Kirchner lived in Davos, Switzerland, from 1918 until he died in 1938. During this period, he made the mountain landscape and its inhabitants his central pictorial theme. In this painting, Kirchner worked predominantly with cool colour tones, making the clear mountain air and the tranquillity of the Alpine landscape palpable.
