Monet (1840-1926) used the technique of "short brushstrokes" and perfected it. With this technique, he succeeded in capturing the flickering of the air over the water in a unique way. For a detailed reproduction, the Monet painting was transferred directly onto artist canvas using the colour-brilliant Fine Art Giclée process and mounted on a wooden stretcher frame like an original oil painting. With the wooden canvas wedges, the canvas can be re-stretched in case of temperature and humidity fluctuations. The elegant hand-glided solid wood frame completes the look perfectly.
