"Boldness of light - modesty of shadow" - Rodin composed this dialogue of elevations and depressions into the "skin" of his sculptures. Rodin was far ahead of his time with his modern stylistic idiom, which abandoned the monument-like pose of the academic style and brought mental constitutions to life on moving surfaces.
