Since ancient times, the laurel has been considered a special honour. It is considered a symbol of glory, victory and peace. Victorious commanders adorned themselves with a laurel wreath, and the winners of sporting competitions received it as a tribute. Wunderlich created the leaf on the occasion of the 1972 Olympic Games. With the exception of the ring containing the central torso of the victor, the Olympic rings are discreetly grouped in the bleed. The laurel leaves were highlighted in relief with an additional relief printing.
