This is a world premiere, as it is the first time that the motif has been published screen printed on handmade paper! In the 1960s, when Andy Warhol discovered a photo print of the film star and sex symbol Marilyn Monroe at a flea market, he did not yet know that he was about to set a milestone in art history. The first time Warhol experimented with serial alienation was through screenprinting. An very soon, he would have created an icon of modern art. Each screenprint bears the embossed relief seal of the Andy Warhol Foundation. The selected fine silver frame with bevel cut passe-partout and colour-coordinated inlay banding shows off the picture to its best advantage and creates a splendid frame for this exclusive edition.
