The Dutch artist Evert den Hartog is a master of moments. In multiple ways, as den Hartog has made a name for himself in the international art scene over the past decades, both as a photographer and a sculptor. Whether he captures reality with a camera or creates that very reality with the tools of a sculptor, often using just his bare hands, is irrelevant. The approach is the same. The results are composed artworks that resemble "frozen moments" ("Frozen Moments" is also the title of a monograph about den Hartog) and have been captivating collectors and museums for a long time.

To understand this, one need only take a look at his "Flying Owl," which is best described as a chain of (seemingly) paradoxes: The work is a thoroughly natural depiction and, at the same time, a mirror-symmetrical abstraction. It depicts a moving stillness, and one can almost "hear" a rushing silence.
