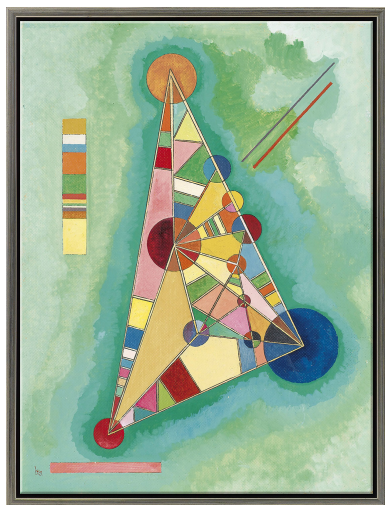




Wassily Kandinsky: Picture "Colour Triangle" (1927), framed

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Wassily Kandinsky was a synaesthete, which means that he perceived colours, forms and sounds across the senses. Thus, it was probably not only his extensive art theoretical reflections that led him to his dynamic compositions of geometric elements and contrasting colours. However, the remarkable effect of these works, which were created especially during his Bauhaus period (1922-1933), are visible even to the "normal" viewer.
