The German sculptor Kurt Arentz (1934-2014) was able to give the classical subject of animal sculpture its very own twist. Although Arentz always emphasised the typical features of the animals, he never strove for naturalistic perfection. He left the surfaces uneven and visibly structured, thus giving each of his figures a very individual character - including this study of a foal. Kurt Arentz had made a name for himself worldwide with sculptures and busts in bronze. In 2001 he received the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany. He was the recipient of numerous prizes, and many of his works can be seen in public spaces in Europe and America.
