Wunderlich has characterised the female figure with geometric clarity. The crowning crescent moon refers to the moon goddess Diana. Diana is the goddess of free nature, fertility and hunting, the tutelary goddess of women and childbirth. As a virgin, mother and huntress, Diana represents the cycle of birth, life and death, as it is also reflected in the phases of the moon. She corresponds in many ways to the Egyptian Isis, and among the Greeks, she was called Artemis. Her cult was widespread throughout the ancient world.
