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As he aged, Degas became increasingly blind, making it impossible for him to paint. But his creative power remained undiminished. He therefore increasingly shifted his focus towards small sculptures, which also secured him an eternal reputation as a sculptor. The "Spanish Dancer" was the first cast by Hébrand in 1900.

Original: Bronze, between 1882-1900, Musée d'Orsay, Paris.
