"Musica letitiae comes medicina dolorum" (Music is a companion to joy and medicine for pains) is the inscription on the instrument. However, it remains unclear whether this refers just to music: The lady making music only appears to be completely absorbed in her playing. In contrast to the rearview, her reflection discreetly reveals that she is also interested in the gentleman standing next to the virginal.
