His statues, wall reliefs and fountains, groups of figures, material pictures and exhibitions in Germany and abroad have made the painter and sculptor Rainer Stiefvater well-known throughout the world. Therefore, this work, which was only published in a small edition for collectors and which solemnly praises the beauty of creation, may soon be sold out very soon.

The artist, who was fond of mystery cults, was inspired to create his archaic frontal figure by sculptures from the Freiburg Cathedral. In doing so, he went back to their natural-cultural sources, to the Magna Mater, once celebrated as the mistress of the earth with orgiastic spring festivals. This cycle symbolises the growth rings rising from her shoulders. On her back, she carries a lizard, which has been a symbol of the dark powers since the High Middle Ages.
