"It was he among all of us who gave the colour its brightest and purest sound, as bright and pure as his whole being was," Franz Marc wrote an obituary dedicated to his friend August Macke in 1914. Macke had discovered some of Marc's lithographs during a visit to Munich in 1910 and sought contact with him. In the same year, he accepted Marc's invitation to Tegernsee, where he painted his 'Sailing Boats'.
