Monet (1840-1926) used the technique of "short brushstrokes" and perfected it. With this technique, he succeeded in capturing the flickering of the air over the water in a unique way. For a detailed reproduction, the Monet paintings were transferred directly onto artist canvas using the colour-brilliant Fine Art Giclée process and mounted on wooden stretcher frames like an original oil painting. The wooden canvas wedges allow the canvas to be restretched in case of temperature and humidity fluctuations. The elegant hand-glided solid wood frame completes the look perfectly.
