For a detailed reproduction, the Monet paintings were transferred directly onto artist canvas using the colour-brilliant Fine Art Giclée process and mounted on wooden stretcher frames like an original oil painting. The wooden canvas wedges allow the canvas to be re-stretched in case of temperature and humidity fluctuations. The elegant hand-glided solid wood frame completes the look perfectly.
