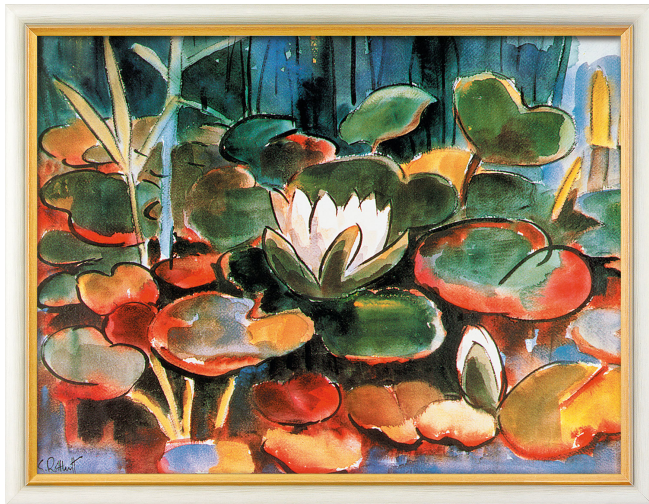




Karl Schmidt-Rottluff: Picture "Water Lilies" (1934), framed
