The treatment of Kirchner's work during the Nazi era is exemplary of National Socialist art policy: more than 600 of Kirchner's paintings were removed from museums. His "Coffee Table" from 1923 bears witness to his preoccupation with Cubism due to the perspective chosen but it evidently is a work by Kirchner when paying attention to its two-dimensional abstraction. It depicts a family conversation as a moment of intimate familiarity and serene tranquillity. It invites the viewer to join in, not least through its luminous, warm colours.
