It is a well-known fact in Germany that they whistle idiomatically from the rooftops and not from the treetops: Sparrows, especially the house sparrow as the best-known of the three species found in Germany, are cultural followers and live near human settlements - preferably in villages with agriculture, where they find plenty of food. But populations are declining significantly, modern agriculture and the increasing sealing of the landscape are making their lives difficult. In 2002, the former common bird was even declared "Bird of the Year" by the German Nature and Biodiversity Conservation Union (NABU).

Bronze sculpture, cast using the Lost-Wax-Process, chiselled and patinated by hand. Size $7 \times 6 \times 12 \text{ cm}$ (h/w/d). Weight approx. 0.3 kg. Can be fastened using the threaded pin supplied.
