The Kestrel - Bird of the Year 2007 in Germany - could be seen as a kind of link between animal nature and human civilisation. It is the most common falcon in Central Europe and probably the best known because it likes to make human settlements its nesting grounds. Schinzel shows the powerful bird of prey gazing attentively into the distance - and perhaps also observing the curious human activity around it.

Sculpture in bronze, cast using the Lost-Wax-Process, patinated and polished. Directly cast from the original. Limited edition of 199 copies, numbered and with the signature of Prof. Schinzel taken from the original as well as the foundry hallmark. Includes a hand-numbered certificate.
