August Macke spent his time between November 1909 and November 1910 at Tegernsee in the "Staudacher's House", which his then newly-wed wife Elisabeth described as follows: "The house was a solid farmhouse, it had been in the family for generations and had been preserved with tradition and culture. August was able to work freely and unhindered, especially since Staudacher provided him with an old empty workshop as a studio." And so almost 200 works were created here in just one year.

Original: Oil on canvas, 41.5 x 40 cm (h/w), Stiftung Sammlung Ziegler im Kunstmuseum Mülheim an der Ruhr.

The original artwork was transferred onto an artist's canvas made of 100% cotton using the elaborate Fine Art Giclée process, sealed with artist's varnish and stretched on a solid wood stretcher frame. Limited edition of 980 copies with numbered certificate on the back. Framed in golden solid wood frame. Size 73 x 70 cm (h/w).
