Pythia was the name of the priestess who prophesied in the ancient oracle of Delphi. She sat in the temple of Apollo on a bronze tripod above a crevice in the earth. She fell into a trance under the influence of vapours and fumes coming from the opening. The oracle was the most important place of worship in Hellenism and was called the centre of the world.

Sculpture made of fine bronze, cast by hand using the Lost-Wax-Process. Elaborately patinated by hand and partially polished. Limited edition of 90 copies, numbered and signed. Height 91 cm, width 50 cm, depth 16 cm. Weight 22 kg.
