Stargazing is the origin of all science, and today, as thousands of years ago, human beings look up at the firmament with fascination. Knuth Seim's "Stargazer" is no exception - armed with a long telescope, he gazes at the glittering firmament. Seim portrays him with almost dramatic body tension: His feet are slightly bent for a secure stand, and his head tilted far back. He seeks to grasp his target. Seim, born in 1961 in Karl-Marx-Stadt (Chemnitz), returns to his artistic roots with the Stargazer. Since a study visit to Senegal, the trained stonemason and sculptor has mainly worked in a simple, reduced style. But with this sculpture, he once again realises his motif figuratively and realistically.

The figure was originally created as a design for a sculptural group for the Märkischer Platz in the "City of Optics" Rathenow.
