In 1959, the Hadassah Hebrew University Hospital commissioned a set of 12 glass-painted windows from Chagall. These windows, intended for a synagogue yet to be built, would symbolise the 12 tribes of Israel. The Chagall Committee approached Bernardaud to entrust the porcelain manufacturer with the production of a few selected items using motifs from the existing archive. The Hadassah Medical Center in Jerusalem is one of the most modern medical facilities in the Middle East and is open to people of all religions.

6 individual plates, each decorated with one of the numerous poetic, fairytale motifs from the artist's oeuvre: "Tribu de Benjamin", "Tribu de Lévi", "Tribu de Simeon", "Tribu de Juda", "Tribu de Ruben" and "Tribu de Zabulon".
