The inspiration for the snail object was the "mountain snail", which Hundertwasser designed as a landmark for the thermal village of Bad Blumau. He designed the hotel complex as an architectural example that harmonises with nature. He realised the complete grass and forest covering of the roofs through various architectural forms such as the Eye-slit houses, the Forest-courtyard house and the Rolling-hills houses.

Hundertwasser's pictures and architecture touch many people's deep-rooted longing for beauty and diversity. He also designed objects of everyday life: "One must enjoy owning these things and must admire and honour them, also because one always discovers new contents..."
