As the centre of cultic games and the noblest sacrifice to the mother goddess, the bull was always held in high esteem by the Minoans. The uniquely beautiful bull's head rhyton - a masterpiece from Knossos - served as a libation vessel for the priestesses, with Cretan wine flowing from its nostrils. Original: Heraklion Archaeological Museum, Crete. New Palace Knossos. Late Minoan, 16th century B.C. The replica impresses with its quality and excellent material workmanship. The green-black polymer ars mundi museum replica (cast by hand) contrasts effectively with the gilded horns. Width 25 cm, height 42 cm.
