The German sculptor Kurt Arentz (1934-2014) was able to bring his very own touch to the classical subject of animal sculpture. Although Arentz always emphasised the typical features of the animals, he never strove for perfection. He left the surfaces uneven and visibly structured, thus giving each of his figures a very individual character. This is also evident in this study of a penguin. Kurt Arentz had made a name for himself worldwide with bronze sculptures and busts. In 2001 he received the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany. Furthermore, he was the recipient of numerous prizes and many of his works can be admired in public spaces in Europe and America.
