Paul Wunderlich has repeatedly been inspired by allegorical representations of mythology to create ravishing portraits of women whose charm conquers the hearts of art lovers. Such as the Three Graces "Thalia", "Euphrosyne", and "Aglaia". The Three Graces are of Greek origin and known as the daughters of Zeus and Eurynome under the name Charites. "Thalia" means blossom, "Aglaia" splendour and "Euphrosyne" cheerfulness. Later they were revered by the Romans as muses for poetry and art.
