Between 1908 and 1914, Ernst Ludwig Kirchner spent a total of four summers on the island of Fehmarn. He regarded the island situated in the Baltic Sea as his little paradise. For this painting, he also made the small island town of Burg appear almost paradisiacal - with a strong red and lush green as the dominant colours.
