"The painting 'Nude' is not only the foundation stone of the extensive collection of works by the artist August Macke at the LWL Museum of Art and Culture in Münster, Germany but also an excellent example of the artist's handling of colours and constant engagement with nude painting. His interest lies particularly in the rendering of the figure's posture and form. However, the artist often depicts the facial features - which also becomes clear 'Nude' - in a typified, reduced and abstracted manner. This contrasts with the postures of the models, whom August Macke shows in classical, almost academic poses." (Dr Arnhold, Museum Director, LWL Museum of Art and Culture, Münster)
