The bouquet of flowers is actually a bouquet of colours: The prismatic colours were the main elements with which August Macke composed his painting. He was all about "putting colours together on the board without thinking of a real object" - even when he was depicting a classical subject. Thus, in his "Still Life with Anemones and Blue Book", the emphasis is not on accuracy but colour harmony.
