In 1890, Claude Monet bought a picturesque plot of land in Giverny and devoted himself entirely to designing his garden. He created a paradise with several exotic flowers and ponds with shimmering water lilies. Monet built a Japanese wooden bridge over the water lily pond. Here, he found the motifs for his world-famous water lily and garden paintings, which characterised his late artistic work.
