Wunderlich's Goethe portrait is an ingenious triad: homage to the great poet, reverence for the painter Tischbein, who painted Goethe's famous portrait in the Campagna in Rome in 1786-87, and last but not least, a "typical Wunderlich" with Mannerist stylistic elements. The cooling towers of a power station appear in the background: signs of Goethe's topicality, his work as an "energy power station" of culture - but also signs that the environment has changed.
